ABSTRACT:

In the past few years we have witnessed massive excitement in the industry about wearable health technology. Apple, Google, Samsung and many other technology companies are entering the expanding market of population health with the introduction of various wearable devices, including fitness trackers, smart watches, connected headsets, smart glasses, personal trackers, wrist bands, etc. In this teaching seminar, I will introduce some basic notions about wearable health device, as well as its market segments, new trends and challenges that we observed in the industry.
